In Raleigh take the I-440 Beltline.

- If you are coming on the Inner Beltline (from Wade Avenue Direction), take Exit 7 and bear right on the exit ramp merging into Glenwood Avenue (going away from Crabtree Valley Mall).
- If you are coming on the Outer Beltline (from the Capital Blvd. Direction), take Exit 7A onto Glenwood Avenue.

On Glenwood Avenue, take a left onto Woman's Club Drive at the traffic light. Woman's Club Drive will become a traffic circle, half way through the circle bear right onto National Drive. Our building is at the end of the cul-de-sac on the right. We're in the Cumberland Building, Suite 201.

You must BRING each of the following:

- 1) Your Citation (ticket)
- 2) Your driver's license or other photo ID
- 3) \$100 payment for the class in the form of money order, credit card, or debit card - (Money orders made to: Safety and Health Council of NC)

The DDC-ADD class must be completed within the time ordered by the court.
